Ricky Farbe-Property owner on Bayou De Sot advised the Jury that the Parish Civil Works Director authorized a resident to grade a portion of the road. While doing so Mr. Farbe advises the individual caused damage to his property by widening the road from 18 feet to 40 feet, further removing dirt from his property to add to the road.

On motion by Jacob Coco, seconded by Bobby Bordelon, to allow the Village of Plaucheville to install a 4 inch water line for residents of Dufour Lane. On vote, the motion carried.

After a public hearing, with no objection from the audience, on motion by Bobby Bordelon, seconded by Mark Borrel, the Avoyelles Parish Police Jury authorizes scarifying Pecan Drive in its entirety. On vote, the motion carried

After a pubic hearing, with no objection from the audience, on motion by Jacob Coco, seconded by McKinley Keller, to reduce speed on Grisville Road to 15 mp.h.. On vote, the motion carried.

On motion by Mark Borrel, seconded by Charles Jones, to adopt the Tourist Commissions 2021 Proposed Budget. On vote the motion carried.

On motion by Bobby Bordelon, seconded by Jacob Coco, advertise calling for a public hearing on December 8, 2020 at 4:45 p.m. to adopt the 2020 amended budget and the 2021 proposed budget. On vote, the motioned carried.

On motion by Jacob Coco, seconded by Bobby Bordelon, to advertise calling for public hearing on December 8, 2020 at 4:50 p.m to hearing objections to allow a gate to be installed and use of Bayou De Sot be restricted to certain hours. On vote, the motion carried.

On motion by Mark Borrel, seconded by Bobby Bordelon, allowing HUD Office to move into the Permit Office and OHSEP Office to move into the HUD Office. On vote, the motion carried.

On motion by John Earles, seconded by Elzie Bryant to accept design exception for Carl Hunt Bridge. On vote, the motion carried.

On motion by John Earles, seconded by Mark Borrel, too submit the 2020-2021 LGAP application for aggregate. On vote, the motion carried.

On motion by Glenn McKinley, seconded by John Earles to reject FEMA Safehouse bids. On vote, the motion carried.

On motion by Mark Borrel, seconded by Jacob Coco, the Avoyelles Parish Police Jury did canvass elections results. On vote, the motion carried.

On motion by Mark Borrel, seconded by Elzie Bryant, the Avoyelles Parish Police Jury does hereby grant authority to the Secretary-Treasurer to pay all bills and to waive a reading of the whole. Motion carried.
